

Do you agree to the following conditions?

- There is a reasonable expectation that your medical situation will allow you to use and benefit from your service dog's skills for 8 to 10 years.
- Your service dog will spend most of his/her time with their partner at home AND at work, school, and social events if he/she is certified for public access that your service dog will not be in a yard or kennel for long periods of time.
- Your service dog is not a family pet - he/she has a specific function in your life and minimal interaction with others.
- You and your service dog are ambassadors for CrittersWork Service Dog Partners, Inc., as well as for the entire assistance dog industry, and you will maintain your service dog's appearance and manners, as well as your handling skills.
- Your service dog cannot be allowed off leash except in a secure area. Exercise and elimination must be done on leash or in a fenced yard or a dog run.
- You will assume responsibility for all medical care for your service dog as prescribed by your veterinarian and routine annual care as directed by CSDP.
- You will provide your service dog with good quality dog food and maintain your dog's proper weight.
- You will provide your service dog with exercise for a minimum of 30 minutes twice a day, and weekly opportunities to interact with new and different dogs.
- You will assume full responsibility for cleaning up after if your dog eliminates in public and for repairing any damage caused by your dog.
- In Class, you will be taught training techniques and appropriate behavior for your service dog. Additionally, you will be required to complete an annual recertification to verify your service dog is exhibiting appropriate behavior in public. You will work with your service dog to maintain appropriate behavior and you will make yourself available for annual recertification.
